**Notes:**

- This legislation was approved by a vote of 15 Y – 5 N (75% approval) on November 29, 2007. The legislation required a 3/5 majority (60%).
- The actual recommendation for all groups was \$203.47. The charter stipulates that the amount be rounded up to the nearest dollar, with the difference going to the SAFC. As a result, SAFC received an additional \$0.53.
- Groups that were new to this byline cycle: Athletics, Cornell Minds Matter.
- The new amount of \$204.00 represents a 13% increase in funding from the previous cycle.
