**Progress Report (Fall 2010):**

The SAORC met a total of 6 times last semester from the sixth week of classes onward. The first five weeks of classes were spent establishing a review process that is consistent with the objectives of the Student Assembly Finance Commission, the Student Assembly, and the Student Activities Office.

**The SAORC reviewed a total of 58 organizations last semester.** In addition, we met with groups that we thought could potentially have overlap of purpose, and/or potentially break funding guidelines only to discover that they were in accordance with the SAFC guidelines and the SAORC's charge. As per the review process, the SAORC reviews organizations in categories (in accordance with the categories used by the Student Activities Office). The categories of groups the committee reviewed in the fall of 2009 are **Theatre; Architecture, Art and Planning;** and **Law** Groups.
