Rationale of the Committee

The committee felt that the student-led Every1 Campaign initiative addresses a pressing need on campus and should be supported by the Student Assembly, particularly in light of recent incidents on campus. However, some committee members felt that not enough planning had gone into the production of the videos, specifically around negotiating the price per minute of production. Committee members also felt that the Every1 Campaign had not explored alternative sources of funding in enough depth. In addition, members of the committee believed that there has not yet been enough Student Assembly participation in the event to merit the level of Special Projects funding requested in the original proposal. The committee believed that the most productive use of funds currently would be the Sexual Health Resource Booklets, which were funded in full, and that after further collaboration more funding could possibly be obtained in the future.

Stipulations

If approved by the Student Assembly, the Every1 Campaign will be requested to work with the Student Assembly Health Taskforce in coordinating logistical and funding efforts for their aforementioned requests. The Campaign will also be requested to seek out as many alternative sources of funding possible and to return any unneeded money to the Student Assembly.

Vote Totals

The Committee votes down, from the highest number proposed to the lowest, to give the group the advantage. The vote totals from the Committee were as follows:
