1 Whereas,

3 An unnecessary burden is placed onto students seeking to study Government due to
4 discussion section scheduling conflicts that arise after classes have begun.

8 There is a strong consensus amongst students that Government discussion section times
9 should be made available during pre-enrollment.

11 Be it therefore resolved that Government courses must allow students to pre-enroll in both
12 lecture and discussion section during pre-enrollment, as is consistent with other departments
13 within the College of Arts and Sciences.

15 Be it further resolved that all of the schools and colleges are further encouraged to ensure that
16 this practice is standard throughout the University.

18 Be it finally resolved that this resolution is forwarded to the Registrar of the College of Arts and
19 Sciences, the Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences, and the Faculty Senate Educational
20 Policy Committee.
