- 1 Whereas, the SAFC is an essential funding organ on campus as well as a promoter of student
2 activity,

4 Whereas, the SAFC funds approved administrative expenses for qualified groups,
5
6 Whereas, Cornell University no longer provides web hosting to registered student
7 organizations,

9 Whereas, a strong web presence improves a group's ability to publicize itself and recruit new
10 members,

12 Be it therefore resolved that the Section 8.1.2 of the SAFC funding guidelines be amended to
13 allow groups the opportunity to apply for funds to spend on web hosting under the
14 administrative expense category,

16 Be it further resolved that the amount a group can spend on web hosting is capped by the
17 administrative expense category cap of \$200 per semester,
18
19 Be it further resolved that the language of the SAFC funding guidelines be amended to reflect
20 this change: under 8.1.2 permitted expenses, "6. web hosting" will be added.
