- 7 Whereas, MVR has a printing station with only 1 printer hidden on the First Floor Dean's Room

- 10 Whereas, this printer is not maintained or serviced regularly, out of paper, or out of ink;

- 12 Whereas, there is a strong consensus that Human Ecology students want a Quick Print Station
- 13 located in a convenient area in the MVR building;

- 15 Be it therefore resolved, a quick service Net-Print station consisting of 2 new printers be
- 16 installed and regularly maintained in one location: either upstairs by G73, downstairs near exit
- 17 of G71, or around the corner by Martha's;

- 19 Be it further resolved, that this resolution is forwarded to the Dean of Human Ecology, the
- 20 Assistant Dean of Human Ecology and the Cornell Information Technologies;

- 22 Be it finally resolved, the Dean's Undergraduate Advisory Council presents this resolution at
- 23 their next meeting on December 6th
