1 2	Whereas, Article III, Section 5 of the Student Assembly Charter states:
3	Section 5: University Calendar
4	A. The Provost will consult with the SA in the formulation of the University Calendar. The SA
5	may review and ask for reconsideration of the calendar before it becomes final. In addition, the
6	SA may propose changes in the calendar to the Provost.
7	B. The Provost shall make the calendar available for comment at least thirty days before public
8	announcement of the final calendar.

10	Whereas, the Student Assembly passed Resolution 47: Undergraduate Student Body
11	Denouncement of the Calendar Committee's Proposal in the spring of 2012;
12	
13	Whereas, the changes to the academic calendar were approved anyway and are now being
14	implemented during the spring 2014 semester;
15	Who were the subsequent above to the final evens askedule have according
16 17	Whereas, the subsequent changes to the final exam schedule have caused many
18	undergraduates great concern for a variety of reasons;
19	Be it therefore resolved, that the SA support the views presented in the attached memo to the
20	University Registrar;

22	Be it further resolved, that the process for input from the constituent assemblies be revisited to
23	allow for more time for review of the final exam schedule before the schedule is published.

25	Be it finally resolved, that this resolution and supporting memo be forwarded to the other
26	constituent assemblies and the Dean of the Faculty.
