1 2 3 4 5	Whereas, the White House has a model for an online petitioning system (petitions.whitehouse.gov), which gives all Americans an opportunity to directly reach the Executive Branch;
6 7 8 9	Whereas, the White House's We The People provides the American people with an additional voice in their government and engages them in issues that matter to them;
10 11 12 13 14	Whereas, the Student Assembly encourages active participation in the shared governance system and seeks to improve the channel of communication between all facets of the University;
15 16 17 18	Be it therefore resolved, that the Student Assembly urges the Administration to create a petitioning platform modeled after that of the White House;
19 20 21 22	Be it further resolved, that any member of the Cornell Community can draft a petition and seek support for it through gathering additional signatures;
23 24 25 26 27	Be it further resolved, that if any given petition garners at least 250 signatures, the relevant assembly must issue a statement and work in collaboration with the petition sponsor(s) to take appropriate action;
28 29 30	Be it finally resolved, that if any given petition garners at least 2,500 signatures, the President of the University, or a designee, must issue a statement responding to the petition's content.
