Student Assembly R. 64: We the Cornellians Petitions Platform

Whereas, the White House has a model for an online petitioning system 1 2 (petitions.whitehouse.gov), which gives all Americans an opportunity to directly reach the 3 Executive Branch; 4 5 6 Whereas, the White House's We The People provides the American people with an additional 7 voice in their government and engages them in issues that matter to them; 8 9 10 Whereas, the Student Assembly encourages active participation in the shared governance system and seeks to improve the channel of communication between all facets of the 11 12 University; 13 14 15 Be it therefore resolved, that the Student Assembly urges the Administration to create a 16 petitioning platform modeled after that of the White House; 17 18 19 Be it further resolved, that any member of the Cornell Community can draft a petition and seek 20 support for it through gathering additional signatures; 21 22 23 Be it further resolved, that if any given petition garners at least 250 signatures, the relevant 24 assembly must issue a statement and work in collaboration with the petition sponsor(s) to take 25 appropriate action; 26 27 28 Be it finally resolved, that if any given petition garners at least 1,000 signatures, the President 29 of the University, or a designee, must issue a statement responding to the petition's content 30 within 30 days.
