



Student Assembly R. 67: Qualifications for College Specific Representatives

- 1 Whereas, members of the Student Assembly are expected to represent the interests of their
2 constituency;
3
- 4 Whereas, eleven voting members of the Student Assembly are to be elected by and from the
5 student populations of the colleges and schools;
6
- 7 Whereas, Student Assembly members who represent specific colleges or schools are
8 expected to be aware of the interest of their constituency for voting on university issues during
9 Student Assembly meetings, and of college/school specific issues to address with their
10 respective dean;
11
- 12 Whereas, being enrolled in a specific college or school will provide a Student Assembly
13 member with more college/school specific resources;
14
- 15 Be it therefore resolved, that effective as of the 2014-2015 school year, any representative
16 formally leaving their constituency must resign their position on the Student Assembly
17 immediately.

- 19 Be it therefore resolved, that Article IV of the SA Charter be amended as follows (amended
20 language is in parentheses):

- 22 Section 1:
23 D. Qualifications for Voting Membership - SA members elected from the various colleges and
24 schools must be registered students in their respective colleges and schools by the beginning
25 of the fall term of the academic year for which they were elected. (SA members must resign
26 their position if they cease to be a registered, full-time undergraduate student in their
27 respective college.)” SA members elected at-large must be registered students at Cornell by
28 the beginning of the fall term of the academic year for which they were elected.
