Student Assembly R. 68: Financial Aid Review Committee Membership Revisions

Sponsor: Matthew Henderson Propose on March 21st, 2014

1 Whereas, Student Assembly committees serve as an important resource and tool for enacting 2 positive changes for undergraduates on campus; 3 4 Whereas, the Financial Aid Review Committee is tasked with examining the financial aid 5 policies of the University and administering the Students Helping Students grant; 6 7 Whereas, the current bylaws of FARC make joining the committee unnecessarily restrictive for interested students: 8 9 10 Whereas, the current bylaws of FARC only allow for the acquisition of new committee members 11 during the start of the fall semester; 12 13 Be it therefore resolved, that Article VI Section 2 Subsection H of the Student Assembly 14 Bylaws be amended as follows (parentheses denote additions, brackets denote deletions); 15 16 Financial Aid Review Committee - The committee will examine the financial aid policies of 17 Cornell University, and review their current status. It shall also be responsible for the 18 administration of the Student(s) Helping Students grant. The committee shall consist of one SA 19 member serving as chair, one additional SA member, (between) five (and ten) undergraduate 20 students, at least four(-fifths) of whom receive some form of institutionalized financial aid, (up 21 to) two faculty members, and one counselor from the Office of Financial Aid[, totaling to ten 22 voting members]. (Interested undergraduate students may apply for Committee membership 23 and will be appointed at the discretion of the SA Staffing Committee.)
