- 15 16 Financial Aid Review Committee - The committee will examine the financial aid policies of
- 17 Cornell University, and review their current status. It shall also be responsible for the
- administration of the Student(s) Helping Students grant. The committee shall consist of one SA
- 19 member serving as chair, one additional SA member, (between) five (and ten) undergraduate 20 students, at least four(-fifths) of whom receive some form of institutionalized financial aid, (up
- to) two faculty members, and one counselor from the Office of Financial Aid[, totaling to ten
- voting members]. (Interested undergraduate students may apply for Committee membership
- and will be appointed at the discretion of the SA Staffing Committee.) The Associate Vice
- Provost for Enrollment, the Directors of Financial Aid, the Associate Director of Financial Aid
- for Customer Service and Community Relations, and the Vice President for Student and
- Academic Services shall serve as ex officio non-voting members.
