Whereas USB requires that performance tier organizations must meet new requirements in 1 2 order to be eligible for funding, 3 Whereas SAFC guidelines should reflect this change, 4 5 6 Be it therefore resolved that the following bolded paragraph be added to the SAFC guidelines: 7 8 9 3.1.6.8 Additional Requirements for Performance Tiers 10 The commission may designate certain tiers as performance tiers. To remain in or advance into a performance tier, organizations must: 11 12 1. fulfill all of the basic requirements to be eligible for that tier; and 2. submit an annual performance report using facilities provided by the Commission; 13 3. submit a Diversity & Inclusion Plan (DIP) in compliance with the guidelines set out for 14 Performance tier groups in United Student Body this requirement may be waived by the 15 commission's executive board if the organization can provide sufficient evidence that the DIP 16 17 task did not carry out its duties properly. 18 19 20 Respectfully submitted, 21 Noah Tulsky
