## **S.A. Resolution # 26 North Campus Quiet Study Space**

**Whereas**, students living on North Campus need quiet study spaces for them to focus on preparing for exams;

**Whereas**, North Campus does not have a public designated quiet study space;

**Whereas**, all libraries located on Central Campus are far away and difficult to get to;

**Whereas**, once winter comes, there are many safety concerns for residents (primarily freshmen) walking from libraries, which are located in Central Campus, back to North Campus during the night after they study;

**Whereas**, community centers on North Campus such as Appel Commons and Robert Purcell Community Center have many free study spaces that students use;

**Whereas**, the Director and Facilities Manager of Residential and Event Services are in support of quiet study spaces on North Campus as an option for those residents;

**Whereas**, a credited class gets preference over study space;

**Be it therefore resolved**, that 3<sup>rd</sup> floor Appel Commons Multipurpose Room (MOR) will be setup with table, chairs, and some wall partitions to accommodate 20-30 people. Quiet Study Space will be setup every Sunday through Thursday 9pm-12am;

**Be it further resolved**, that the Student Assembly freshmen representatives will reevaluate this project in January 2015 and decide whether it is necessary to extend the hours or expand the study space;

**Be it finally resolved**, that the feedback about using this study space from students be shared with all relevant groups and the Student Assembly General Body in the form of a report.
