The Committee is continually impressed by the number of events put on every semester and believes 4-6 events is ideal. The Committee also believes cosponsorships have added a significant impact to the Cornell community and expansion of these programs should be tested for feasibility. Although it is understood that some investigation of optimal pricing has been done, Cornell Concert Commission should continue to look into prices that students would be willing to pay for certain types of concerts. Additionally, the Appropriations Committee believes CCC should do more to determine what Cornellians are listening to based on survey methods and existing data. Finally, the Appropriations Committee encourages investigation into more frequent, larger events in the beginning of the fall semester.
