Rationale of the Committee

The Appropriations Committee recommends funding the Community Partnership Funding Board at \$2.00 for the 2016-2018 By-Line Funding Cycle. The Committee appreciated the extensive amount of work being done by CPFB to substantially impact the Cornell and Ithaca community. The Committee believes that a plan to use carryover to test-run alternative programming is commendable. However, they would like to emphasize the importance of prioritizing grant funding and they believe that CPFB should only plan alternative programming when their carryover represents an excessive amount. Finally, the Appropriations Committee believes that mass-advertising represents a sufficient form of outreach, but they encourage the Community Partnership Funding Board to more personally advertise to student organizations and departments with a community focus that are low on funding.
