On the recommendation of the Judicial Codes Counselor Search Committee, I am pleased to name you to serve as the next Judicial Codes Counselor (JCC) for a term beginning July 1, 2011 and ending June 30, 2012 and as an Associate JCC for a term beginning July 1, 2010 and ending June 30, 2011.
